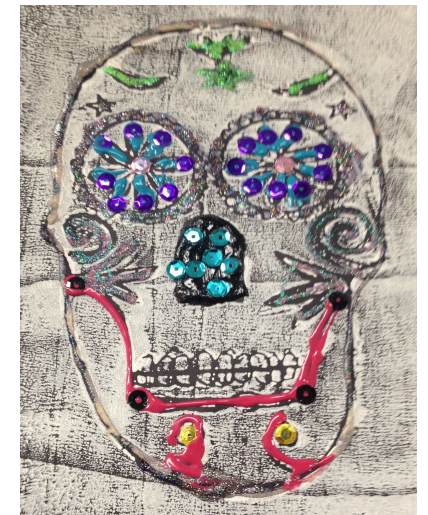
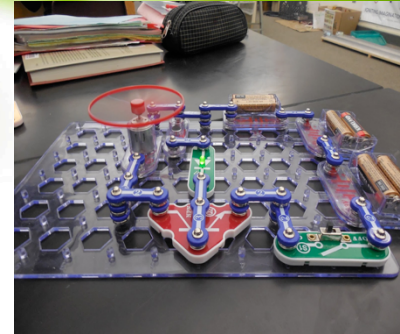

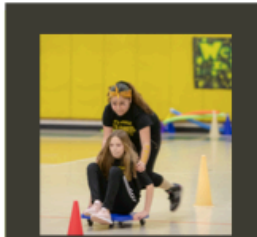

**Homework Clubs – 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup>/7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup>**

Provides time after school for students to work on homework assignments, focus on make up and/or follow-up on any schoolwork. There are certified staff assigned so that they can also assist students with core content area materials.

**Title I Extended Day Program**

– It is designed to assist students in areas where they may need additional academic support. The program IXL, includes a variety of skills and content that are aligned with the Common Core and New Jersey Student Learning Standards, is used in Title I. Entry to this program needs to be approved by administration. Students utilize one-on-one or small group teacher instruction and online resources to develop mastery of skills that help boost performance in the classroom.

**Mentoring** – We have been fortunate to have A.P. Schalick High School students come to PTMS to mentor our students about academic and social concerns. These mentors have also assisted our students with organization and any student assigned work.

## After School Clubs & Activities

**Academic League** – There are six competitions that members of the league will be attending. If the student has a natural passion for academics, competition, and a fascination for general knowledge in a variety of categories, then the Academic League needs him/her.

**Arts/Activities Club\*** – Entails hands on creative art projects including painting, paper maché, clay pottery, and chalk work. The students will be designing and painting a wall mural on one of our school indoor walls this year.

**Band (Cadet)/PTMS Band (Concert)** – Looking to have some fun, make some music and be part of something bigger than yourself? Join the Cadet Band or the PTMS Band! The Cadet Band is made up of 5th and 6th grade students and meets after school one to two times a week. Students in 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade may join the PTMS Band. Students who participate will also have lessons once a week during the school day. Regular practice is required. No prior music experience necessary. Join today!

**Drama/Theatre Club \*** – Mission is to provide students with an interest in theatre and drama as an after school program. We are looking into the possibility of making the next performance a musical!

**Field Day** – Outside and indoor activities that will incorporate both physical and mental competition that will have aspects of S.T.E.M. incorporated throughout the school day.

**Dungeons and Dragons Club \*** – It is a medieval times activity that focuses on student imagination. Students need to strategically plot a medieval campaign on a weekly basis. Once a campaign is finished, the players create new characters to play. In order to begin a new campaign, the key master has to figure out all the components throughout the game in order to win. In the process of these activities, they will be creating new stories for the rest of the players to use in the weekly activities.

**Kids Connect \*** – Purpose is to promote a positive school culture and a more collaborative partnership with parents and members of the community, as we work together to meet the needs and goals of all students.

**National Junior Honor Society** – It is the nation's premier organization established to recognize outstanding middle school level students. More than just an honor roll, NJHS serves to honor those students who have demonstrated excellence in the areas of scholarship, service, leadership, character, and citizenship.

**Science Club\*** – Provides time for students to develop a project that has an interest to them, research their projects, work on the experiments (if applicable), and work on their presentation for the school science fair.

**Student Council\*** – Designed to assist students to share ideas, interests, and concerns with teachers and our school Principal. They often also help raise funds for school-wide activities, including social events, community projects, helping people in need and school reform.

**Renaissance Program \*** – Is an incentive program that recognizes students for their hard work and effort in a variety of ways. The program highlights and rewards students with respect to the following areas: academics, behavior, attendance, community service, and after school participation.

**Wildcat Wildness\*** – Grade level competition against one another through team-building skills and games. Examples of the activities include: Basketball Shoot Out, Dizzy Bat Relay, Sweeper Race, Pie Eating, Obstacle Course, Relay Race, Three-Legged Race, Musical Chairs, Tire Pull, Cookie Face, Elephant Bowling, and Dodge Ball. Wildcat Wildness t-shirts are provided by a grant from the Salem County Youth Services Commission and the New Jersey Juvenile Justice Commission.

## Sports Clubs

**Basketball Club\*** – Ready to learn the game of basketball? If so, this club is for you. You will learn the essence of dribbling, passing, shooting, defense and teamwork. Mission is to provide students with an interest in sports. Students play basketball, watch videos on great sports role models, learn the rules of the game, discuss good sportsmanship, and learn what it means to be a positive role model in the sports scenario.

**Field Hockey\*** – Mission is to learn the fundamentals of this particular sport, including: hand eye coordination, motor skills, rules and regulations, sportsmanship, team building, tolerance, and competitive guidelines as they relate to P.R.I.D.E.

**Soccer Club\*** – This club will introduce students to the exciting sport of U.S. soccer. Students will learn how to dribble, pass, shoot a soccer ball, and protect the net. GOAL!!! Mission is to learn the fundamentals of this particular sport, including: hand eye coordination, motor skills, rules and regulations, sportsmanship, team building, tolerance, and competitive guidelines as they relate to P.R.I.D.E.

**Running Club\*** – If you are interested in either short or long distance running, this club is for you. Come out and join the Running Club to learn proper stretches, breathing, and running techniques.

**Softball Club\*** – This club will provide participants with instruction and techniques on fielding, throwing, batting, and base running. Students will also learn the fundamental rules of the awesome game of softball.

# CORE SUBJECTS

## **Math**

Instruction is based on eight mathematical practices, as outlined by the NJSL, and connects those practices to content standards. Students hone their skills in reasoning and modeling in order to justify responses and apply their learning to real-world scenarios. Resources, including IXL, NJCTL, Khan Academy, and teacher-generated materials, provide students with opportunities to learn both individually and in small groups through a host of activities to develop their problem-solving skills.

## **Language Arts Literacy**

Language Arts will mirror the structure of the math classes. It incorporates both Reading and Writing. It has a balanced approach in accordance to the State standards. It is aligned to the New Jersey Student Learning Standards

## **Social Studies**

Focuses on Colonialism to Early U.S. History & Digital Citizenship along with Geography, American History, and World History.

## **Science**

Science is taught in an integrated approach (Earth, Life, & Physical) at all 4 grade levels in accordance with the NJSL-Science. A host of resources, including Lab Kits, online learning tools, and supplemental readings, are utilized in alignment with the Science & Engineering Practices for a hands-on approach to learning.

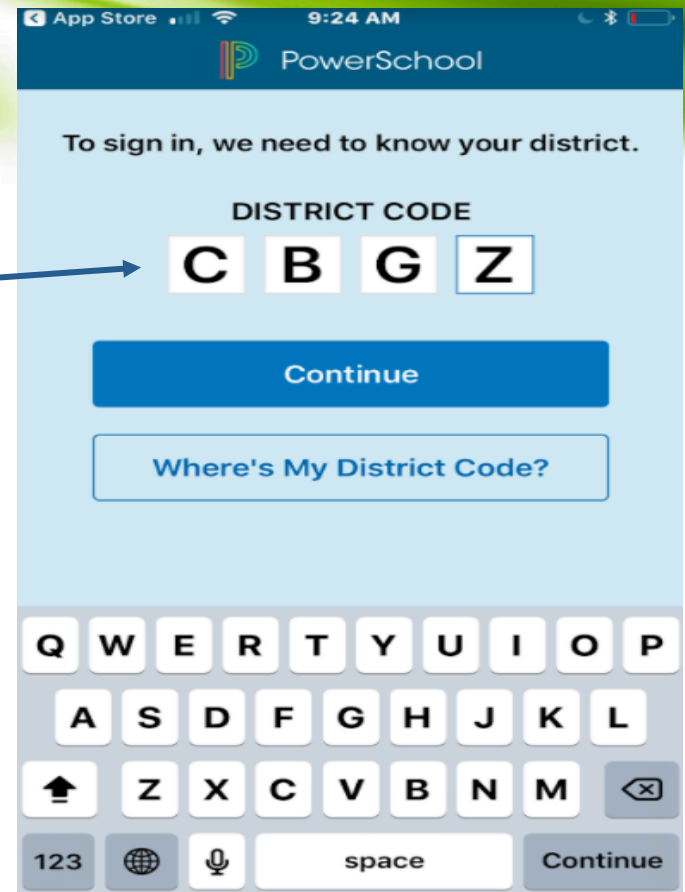

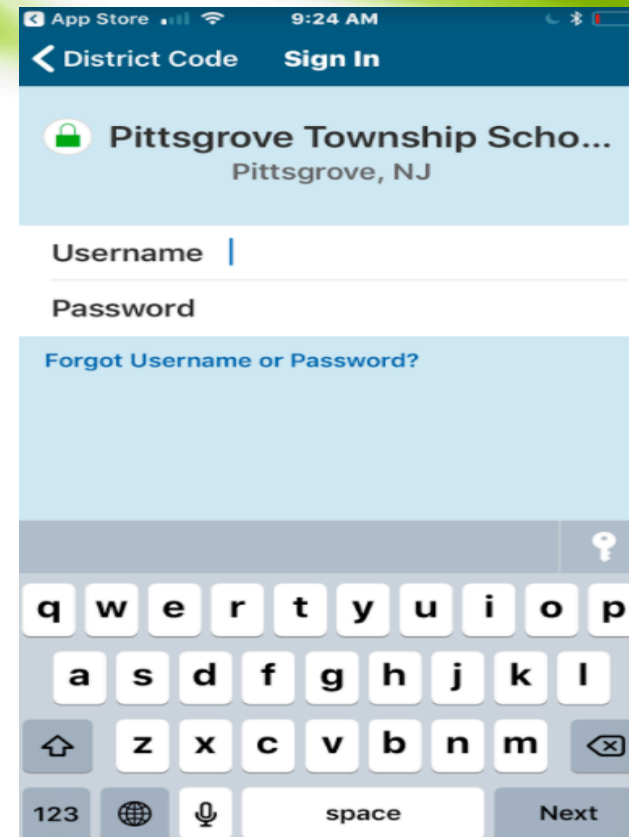

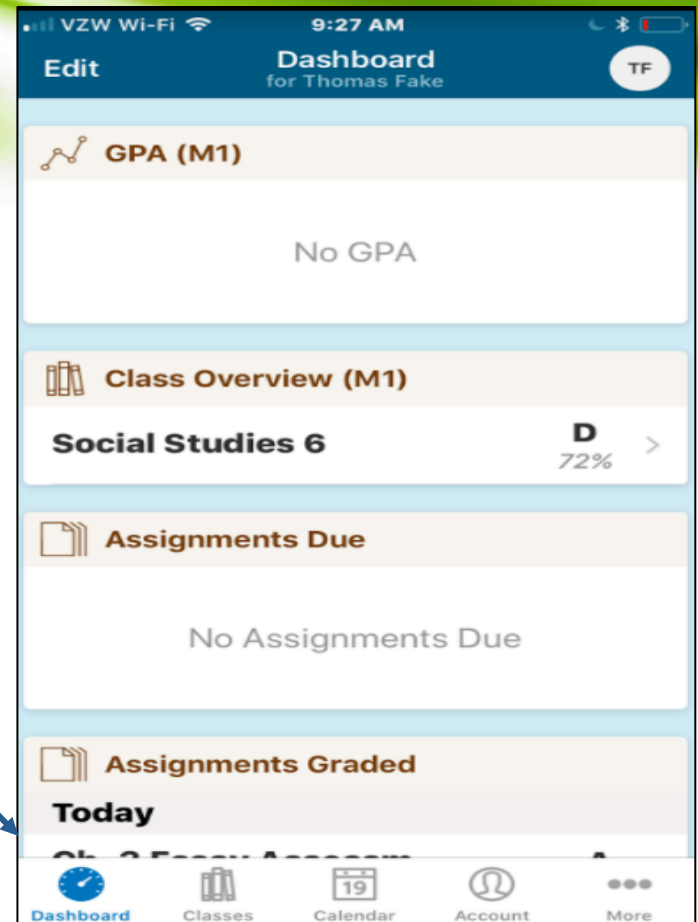




# Cell Phone App Navigation

Click to view class



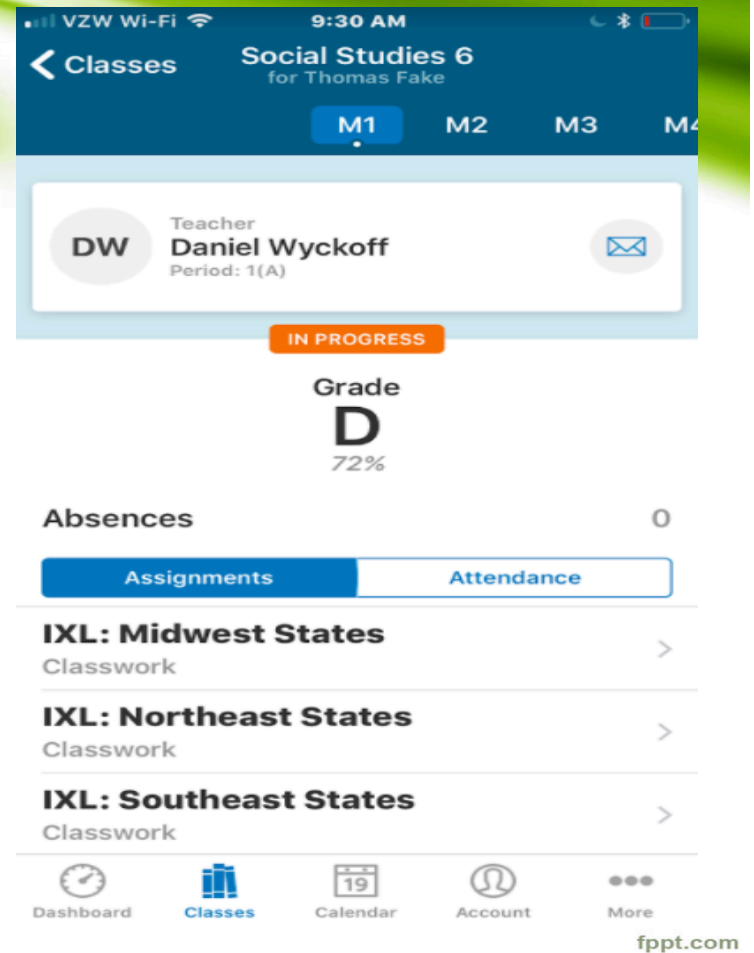


# Cell Phone App Navigation

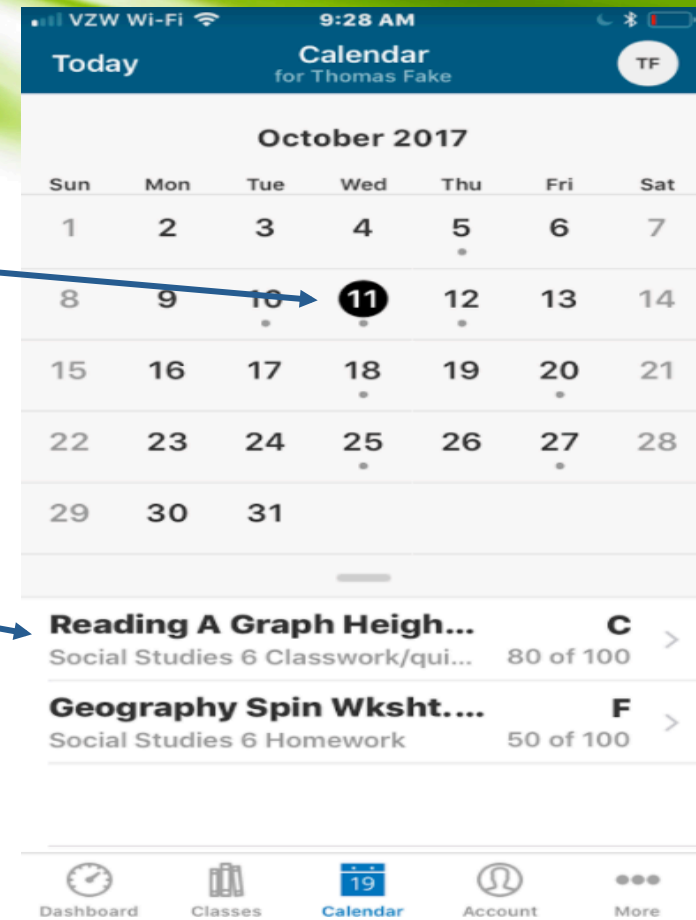

## Calendar View

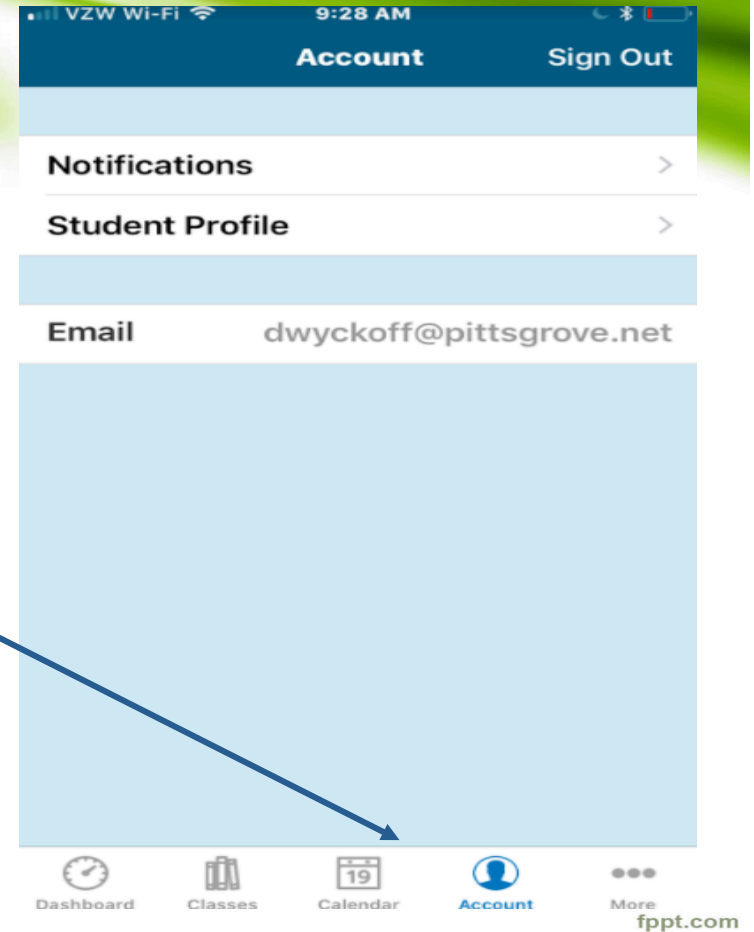

# Why Reconfigure the Schedule?

After collecting feedback from a variety of stakeholders, we redesigned our master schedule using the following guiding questions.

1. How can we **maximize time** that advances student and staff learning?
2. How can we design a schedule to **meet the needs of all students**?
3. How can we **offer unique learning opportunities** for students?

At Pittsgrove, we believe in growing all learners to thrive.

# Advantages

- **Uninterrupted instructional time** for Math and ELA courses
- The schedule provides time for staff to collaborate through PLCs (***Professional Learning Community***) and **common planning** time on a weekly bases.
- **Lunch periods** will be reduced from four lunches to **two lunches**
  - Grade 5 and 6 (10:55 – 11:25 a.m.)
  - Grade 7 and 8 (11:35 – 12:05 a.m.)
  - Grade levels are supervised by grade level teachers.

# Schedule Framework

- English Language Arts and Math classes are 80-minutes daily (***full year***)
- Science, Social Studies and PE are 40-minutes daily (***full year***)
- Exploratory classes will be a 40-minutes daily (***Trimester rotation***)

***\*\* Please note that some minor adjustments will be made to the 5th grade schedule in order to incorporate the 20-minute recess required by the State.***

***\*\* LLD/ICR classes in all core subject areas.***



# RTI Program

**A 40-minute period was built into the schedule** to meet the needs of all learners (*At-Risk, Advanced, ELL, Special Education*) through an RTI model

- Students will be receiving **intensive interventions during this period**
- This period is in addition to the current classes students are already taking

We have formed an **RTI Task Force** to successfully integrate Response to Intervention (RTI) at PTMS for the 2019-2020 school year.

## **The RTI Task Force will:**

- *Review current RTI research and interventions*
- *Establish a shared definition of RTI for PTMS*
- *Plan for RTI programming at PTMS for the 2019-2020 school year*
